

A Collegiate Ministry Lectionary Resource for the Academic Year



The purpose of this lectionary is to give an overview of the Bible in a relatively short period of time to undergraduate and graduate students who may or may not have much experience with the Bible or a community of faith. This resource is designed for use in worshiping communities that follow a semester-based academic calendar. Typical semesters are about 15 weeks long, with the first semester of the academic year in the fall and the second semester of the academic year in the spring. This lectionary may need to be adapted to fit with your particular calendar. This resource is also designed for use over four years (or eight semesters), which is the typical length of time that an undergraduate student will spend working toward a degree. Ideally, this would give a student the opportunity to hear all four Gospels, most of the Psalms, and a large sampling of the remainder of the books of the Bible during their time within a worshiping community. It should be noted that this resource is not designed to replace the Revised (RCL) or the liturgical calendar. Many student-based gather on weekdays rather than Sundays and often do of the most significant Christian festivals (e.g., Pentecost). Ideally, students would celebrate these events in the context of a congregation if their student-faith was not gathering during that time.¹
